The Yamhill County Sheriff's Office is currently establishing an eligibility list for current and anticipated vacancies.

Patrol Deputy: Investigates crimes, complaints and other matters related to law enforcement. Lateral transfers of certified officers are encouraged. Deputies work variable shifts.

Corrections Deputy: Maintains custody, safety, security, and sanitation of prisoners confined in the correctional facility, including inmate counts, meal service, escort, transport, inspection of persons, property, and cells. Report writing on in-house management system.

Reserve Deputy positions are available in both patrol and corrections.

Successful candidates must pass a criminal background check, physical agility test, drug and psychological screens.

Experience in law enforcement or college coursework in related field helpful.

Must be U.S. citizen, possess valid Oregon driver's license and a high school diploma or equivalent. Two years college or equivalent law enforcement experience is preferred.

Minimum age at time of application is 21.

Bilingual and female applicants encouraged to apply.

Employees must be able to perform the essential functions of this classification with or without accommodation.
