**Subject:** Board Consideration: Permission to Apply - Combating Opioid Overdose through Community-level Intervention

Hi Mary and Ken,

I would like permission to apply for the Combating Opioid Overdose through Community-level Intervention grant from the University of Baltimore. We expect our application budget to be approximately \$120,000. While this amount is not specifically included in our Health and Human Services 2020-2021 Adopted Budget, we have sufficient expense authority.

If awarded, the grant will fund 1 full-time equivalent (FTE) for twelve months. The purpose of the grant is to implement or enhance new or on-going community-based programs that aim to reduce opioid or other drug overdoses; assess efficacy of these efforts; and support and promote collaboration between public safety and public health agencies.

If our application is successful, I will return to the Board to request approval for the actual amount awarded and additional position management authority.

Suggested Board Agenda language: "Authorize Lindsey Manfrin or designee on behalf of Yamhill County Public Health to submit an application for the Combating Opioid Overdose through Community-level Intervention grant from the University of Baltimore."
