1. **B.O. 20-166** - Consideration of Amendment #11 to the agreement between Yamhill County Health and Human Services and Lutheran Community Services Northwest (B.O. 12-555) for outpatient counseling and treatment services covered by the Oregon Health Plan in the amount of \$24,014.66. Effective May 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020.

2. **B.O. 20-167** – Consideration of authorizing Community Justice and the Sheriff’s Office to submit a grant application for the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) FY2020 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) program for financial support to local governments for program and service expansion in response to COVID-19.
