2. Approval of an amendment to an engagement agreement between Yamhill County and Harrang Long Gary Rudnick for outside legal services.
3. Authorize a notice of intent to award the Yamhill County 2019 Overlay Project to Knife River Corporation, total base plus alternate bid \$1,479,740.25.
