Shall Willamina School District build new facilities by issuing general obligation bonds for \$2,000,000?

If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of Sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary 175 words


If approved, this measure would provide new facilities and make facility improvements. Specifically, this measure is expected to finance:

- *Add new modular classrooms to the elementary school by replacing modulares purchased in 1978.
- *Add new wood/metal/agriculture shop with additional classroom space.
- *Add fire suppression sprinkler system, including pump, line and pond improvement.
- *Pay for site improvements for the above projects and bond issuance costs.

Bonds would mature in a period not to exceed ten (10) years. The overall tax rate for bonds is estimated to be approximately \$0.64 per \$1,000 of assessed property value.
