I would hope that you would look at the proposal made by Lindsey Manfrin. I went to the website suggested by Commissioner Berschauer, "Song for Charlie". I liked how the parents took their pain and created something to help others. However, since it is a nationwide website, it does not have information on resources that are specific to Yamhill County.

I believe it would be better to create a website designed specifically for our county. It would include the resources that are available here locally. The company that Director Manfrin would like to use is an Oregon company, and I do believe we should support Oregon companies first. Also, once it is created the control would be turned over to the health department, where it could be readily updated. Also, it should be noted that the creation of this site would not cost the county anything as the funds come from OHA for education.

We desperately need to do something as a county to help our citizens, especially our young people, recognize the dangers of fentanyl. And we need to provide them with local resources to help.

Please reconsider Director Manfrin's proposal for the creation of this important website.
