**Final Ballot Title** The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the city's voters. The ballot title notice has been published and the ballot title challenge process has been completed.

Prohibits psilocybin-related businesses within the City of Newberg.

Shall the City of Newberg prohibit psilocybin-related businesses in the City of Newberg?

State law allows for the manufacturing, transportation, delivery, sale and purchase of psilocybin, the psychedelic drug found in certain mushrooms. State law provides that a local government may adopt an ordinance to be referred to the voters to prohibit the establishment of licensed psilocybin product manufacturers and/or psilocybin service centers. The Newberg City Council adopted an ordinance to refer to the voters prohibiting the establishment of psilocybin-related businesses in Newberg and, as a result, has referred this measure to the voters.

Approval of the measure would prohibit the establishment of psilocybin product manufacturers and psilocybin service centers within the Newberg city limits.



**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:**

Approval of this measure would prohibit the establishment and operation of psilocybin-related businesses within the City of Newberg.

A city council may adopt an ordinance prohibiting the establishment of psilocybin related businesses within the city, but the council must refer the ordinance to the voters at a statewide general election. The Newberg City Council has adopted an ordinance prohibiting the establishment of psilocybin-related businesses within the City of Newberg and, as a result, has referred this measure to the voters.
