ORS 249.088 Nomination to Nonpartisan Office.

The offices of Assessor and Commissioner may be won at the Primary Election if;

- A) Only one (1) candidate files for this office in the Primary Election.
- B) Or two (2) or more candidates file for this office and one (1) receives the majority of votes (50% +1).

A candidate will be nominated at the Primary Election and go forward to the General Election if;

- A) Two (2) or more candidates file for this office and no one receives the majority of votes at the Primary Election. The top two (2) vote getters are then nominated to go forward to the General Election.
- B) The race is a County Sheriff, Clerk or Treasurer
