Dear City of McMinnville Voter:

The Yamhill County Clerk's office has re-issued a supplemental ballot for all McMinnville voters for the 2014 General Election – November 4, 2014.

We erroneously listed all three City Council races on all ballots. In McMinnville, only those living in a Ward can vote for the Councilor for that Ward.

We ask all voters to vote the enclosed supplemental ballot for their McMinnville City Councilor.

In addition to voting your initial ballot, please be very careful to:

1. Also vote this ballot
2. Insert this ballot into its own Secrecy envelope
3. Insert only this Secrecy envelope with only this ballot into the blue envelope enclosed (marked in red ink with the phrase "McMinnville City Council Supplemental Ballot" on the back flap)
4. Sign the blue envelope
5. Return the ballot to us before 8 pm on Election night (November 4, 2014) (you may use any of the drop sites in Yamhill County)

2 Ballots required for this election:

- Vote your original ballot, sign its envelope and get that to us
- Vote your "supplemental" ballot (enclosed), sign its envelope and get it to us separately
