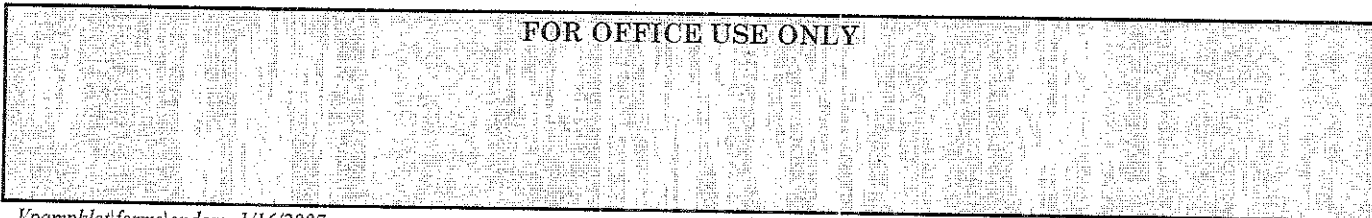

# Instructions

If the name of a person or organization is used in your argument/statement as supporting or endorsing the argument/statement, **you must either:**

1. Use the name of the person or organization with a quotation made by the person on behalf of the person or by an authorized person on behalf of an organization. The quotation must have been disseminated to the public prior to its inclusion in the argument/statement and it must be identified in the argument/statement by its source and the date (such as the name of the newspaper in which it appeared) and the date of dissemination/publication. Examples for identifying the source of a quote are:

James Joyce, *The Oregonian*, 1/22/90  
Bob Dole, *Time Magazine* July 7, 1997  
John F. Kennedy, *Profiles in Courage*, 1960

OR

2. File a "Statement of Endorsement" signed by the person, or by an authorized person on behalf of an organization, stating that the person consents to the use of the name of the person or organization in the argument/statement. An organization's name should only be used if the organization is endorsing the argument/statement.

This "Statement of Endorsement" should be filed with the argument/statement it relates to and must be file no later than the voters' pamphlet filing deadline.

**NOTE:** If a "Statement of Endorsement" is not received, the person or organization whose name is mention will be edited from the statement or argument. If the information contained in the endorsement designation box on the front of this form does not match what is printed in the argument/statement, the argument/statement will be edited to match the Statement of Endorsement form.

**ORS 251.405 Names of persons or organizations excluded from arguments and statements; exceptions.** (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the county clerk shall not print the name of any person or organization in any argument supporting or opposing any measure or any statement of any candidate, filed for inclusion in a county voters' pamphlet, if the name of the person or organization is cited as supporting or endorsing the argument or statement.

(2) The county clerk may print the name of a person or organization in an argument or statement submitted for inclusion in a county voters' pamphlet as supporting or endorsing the argument or statement if:

(a) Not later than the deadline for filing an argument or statement with the county clerk, the county clerk receives a statement signed by the person, or by an authorized person on behalf of an organization, stating that the person consents to the use of the name of the person or organization; or

(b) The name of a person or organization is used with a quotation made by the person on behalf of the person or by an authorized person on behalf of an organization, the quotation was disseminated to the public prior to its inclusion in the argument or statement and the quotation is identified by its source and date.

(3) A person shall not submit a false signature under subsection (2) of this section. [1989 c.1031 s.12; 1993 c.493 s.22]
